10. Criterion 2 (Water supply)

I. Requirements for Issuance of Permit

Criterion 2 requires that a project or development has sufficient water to meet its reasonably foreseeable needs.

II. Burden of Proof

The burden of proof is on the applicant. 10 V.S.A. §6088(a).

III. Analysis

- 1. Adequate water supply must be demonstrated by the applicant.
- 2. Evidence that supports a finding of sufficient water includes:

Expert hydrological study, showing sufficient available water, recharge to meet water quantity needs, or similar evidence;

Compliance with Vermont Water Supply Rules

Presumptions created by other permits

Certain permits create a rebuttable presumption that the project complies with Criterion 2. They are:

Public Utility permit from the PSB;

Municipal permit from the local water authority;

Subdivision, mobile home park, or campground permit;

Water supply and wastewater disposal permit;

Public water system construction or operating permit.
