This letter is to confirm our telephone conversation of March 25, 1971.

The Vermont Environmental Board met on March 24 to consider your request for a declaratory ruling as to the status of the sewer project in Fire District #1 in the Town of Dover as it pertains to the provisions of 10 VSA Chapter 151 and as outlined in your letter to me of March 17.

The Board voted unanimously on the following motion:

"On the basis of the entire tract of land size and a 20 foot right-of-way width for the lines, the proposed Dover project involves more than ten acres and, therefore, requires a permit from the District Environmental Commission."

On behalf of the Board, let me express our appreciation for your frankness at the meeting on March 24.
