As I stated before I have witnessed plenty of the operations trucks come and go after the 6:00 o'clock PM hours. I have even witnessed trucks full of chopped corn enter the scales after hours on Saturday at the plant but never a truck that appeared to be a delivery or garbage truck. I feel when a company such as Harrison Concrete and Redi-Mix desided to move in to an established residential neighborhood the least they can do is conform to the permit rules they agreed to before they started operations.
