Dear Mr. Merchant:

The work proposed on the properties of the Vermont Railway and Green Mountain Railroad as described by you in your letter to me of July 18, 1975 does not constitute development for the purposes of Act 250 concerning normal maintenance and repair of existing facilities. Therefore, no permit for such maintenance and repair work is required under the Act.

Please be advised that a new facility or substantial change to an existing facility will require a permit. In the event you have a question concerning any particular aspect of proposed work, please contact the District Environmental Coordinator for the area in which the work will be undertaken. For your reference, I am enclosing a directory of coordinators and map delineating their district areas.
